### DJ DYMOND



Resident Kinetic DJ, Dymond controls the atmosphere before, during and after the show by spinning the perfect tunes to dictate the mood.

From chilling the audience out preshow, to making them jump out of their seats during the competitions, there is never a silent moment when Dymond is on the decks.

His popularity and music selection expertise has grown to such levels that we now host an 'Aftershow Party' with Dymond and other spinning tunes for those that want to dance till the early morning.

### MARCUS

Behind the scenes Marcus is in charge of ensuring everything flows smoothly with all the technology.

From managing the Twitter Wall, to setting up and controlling the Xbox, Kinect and Projectors to ensure the entertainment and audience experiences go without a hitch.

Also a keen dancer, Marcus can also be found on stage demonstrating the dance moves for the regular Dance Central 'Who thinks they can Dance?!' competitions.



## HISTORY

The brainchild of Inel Tomlinson, Kinetic Comedy was spawned out of frustration with poorly run, paint-by-numbers Comedy nights run in dingy function rooms, inside intimidating and unfriendly pubs. Thinking he could create something that not just his friends and his existing fan base would want to see, but an event that would draw in comedy aficionados he didn't know, and even people new to watching standup comedy, Inel turned to long term collaborator Richard Wilson to lay the groundwork for Kinetic. Together, they both set out to build the perfect comedy atmosphere in which people felt comfortable, relaxed and free to have fun.

Several trips to IKEA, numerous meetings in Burger King and hundreds of gigs scouting for talent later, Kinetic found its home upstairs at Islington's stylish and cosy Library bar, smack-back in the middle of Upper Street. On April's Fools Day 2010, with unbelievably strong acts such as 5-Time Comedy Cafe Winner Joel Dommett, Laughtershock star Jason Patterson, and brilliant newcomer Laura Carr, Kinetic launched with a bang, making the sell-out crowd shake and squeal for 2 hours straight.

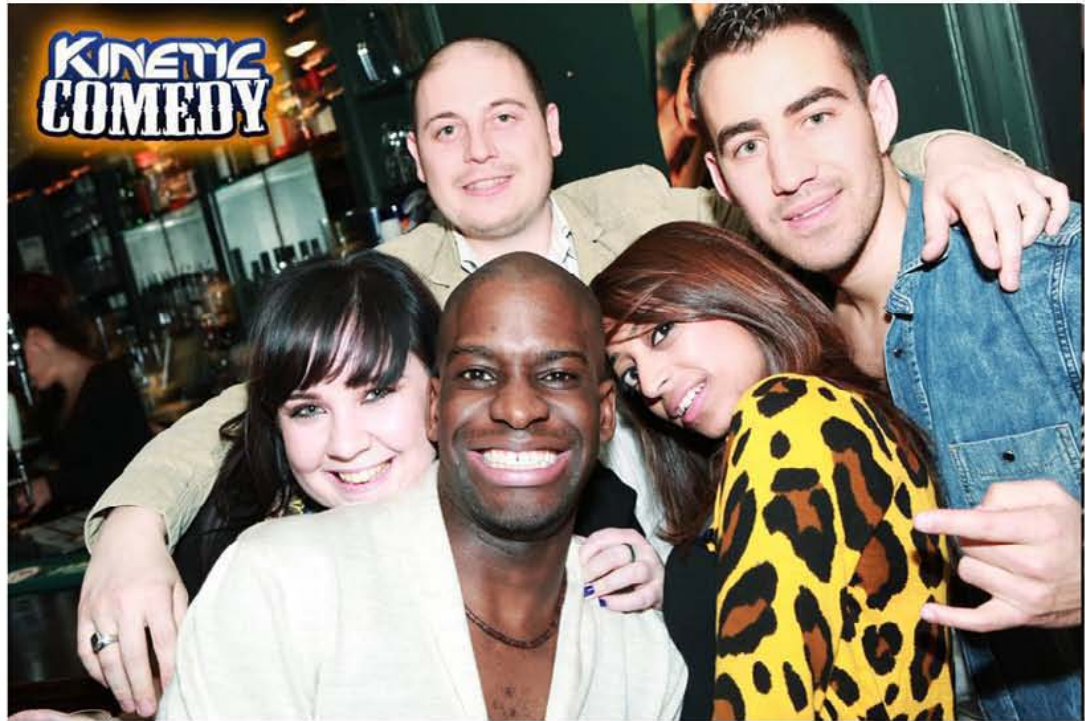
Since then, Inel and Rich have continued to improve the event's organisation, installing a pre-sale ticket system to ensure no seat is left empty, hiring a professional DJ to perform before, during and after the show, and gathering a pool of helpers for the event, to mingle with the crowd and ensure everybody is happy, knows where they're seated, and when the show is about to begin.

After a successful run of shows, sponsorship from Fox's Party Rings and a mid-year break for Edinburgh, Kinetic returned on February 24<sup>th</sup> 2011 in a brand new venue in the heart of Hornsey. Branded as the third season, Kinetic Comedy brought the borough of Hornsey it's first ever comedy night in it's history, attracting the attention of locals, press and fellow comedians.

We hope to continue to push and experiment with new ways to improve. We'll soon begin to showcase exclusive preshot comedy sketches prior to the standup, to encourage punters to arrive earlier, and to further enhance the night's unique atmosphere. We're also looking at avenues for expansion, whether it be even bigger venues or more regular shows, as we look to capitalise on the extraordinary amount of kinetic momentum the event already has.
